
### STATE OF THE DISTRICT: WHERE ARE WE?


PA District Superintendent: REV. MICKEY CLUSTER

**Reminder** — at our July District Conference the DISTRICT DUES were INCREASED to offset the rising cost of running the District. STARTING JANUARY 1, 2023: **\$125** FOR LOCAL, \$150 FOR GENERAL, and \$175 FOR ORDAINED. Also, to be enforced starting this new year is the PA Constitution's policy on District Dues: "Accounts shall be considered delinquent if not remitted by the close of the 15th of the next month following the close of the quarter (Example, first quarter dues must be paid by March 31. A certified letter will be sent after April I5).
